Sectoral Affairs: Highlights | Oct-Dec

In December 2024, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs announced an extension for CSR reporting. What is the new deadline?

The CSR reporting deadline for filing Form CSR-2 has been extended to March 31, 2025.

In November 2024, the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs hosted a key event on CSR. What was its focus?

The national conference focused on innovative CSR practices aligned with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

In October 2024, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) released the 'Women and Men in India 2023' report. What does it highlight?

It highlights gender disparities in areas such as education, health, and economic participation.

In December 2024, the Institute for Human Development published the India Employment Report 2024. What does it cover?

It examines employment trends and provides policy recommendations to address labor market challenges.

In November 2024, MoSPI released 'EnviStats India 2024.' What is its purpose?

It provides comprehensive environmental data to support evidence-based sustainable development decisions.

The Indian government announce an initiative in December 2024 concerning sustainable industry practice. What is it?

India announced a formula for classifying 'green steel,' defining it as steel produced with carbon emissions below 2.2 tonnes per tonne of finished steel. This initiative aims to decarbonize the steel industry, aligning with India's net-zero targets.

In October 2024, the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) launched the Special Campaign 4.0. What does it cover?

It focuses on institutionalizing cleanliness and reducing administrative pendency through activities like plantation drives, cleanliness initiatives, and the disposal of pending references. It also includes innovative measures such as the online 'Swachhta Pledge' and the creation of a dashboard for tracking activities.

Father's Club initiative: Engaging Fathers in Early Childhood Care and Development – Odisha

OneStage is proud to spotlight the transformative work being done under our ECCD program, **Prarambh: Sukhad Shaishab** in Odisha, with a special focus on the **Father's Club initiative.** The programme is implemented by OneStage in collaboration with Department of Women & Child Development and supported by Van Leer Foundation, is rooted in the belief that fathers play an essential role in the holistic development of young children, especially in their formative years from birth to three years.

As an innovative approach, Father's Clubs have been formed, to educate and empower fathers to become equal partners in caregiving



Through regular meetings and interactive activities, **fathers learn about responsive caregiving practices**, early stimulation techniques, and the use of household items as **cost-effective learning tools**. These sessions have not only raised awareness but have also encouraged fathers to actively participate in daily activities like storytelling, lullabies, and playtime.

A recent meeting showcased the innovative use of tools like the *Vikas Vriksh* and story cards wherein fathers engaged in participatory games, shared their experiences, and demonstrated newfound creativity in engaging with their children. The *"Best Father of the Month"* recognition has been a motivating factor, fostering a positive and supportive environment.

By reshaping traditional caregiving roles, the Father's Club is laying the groundwork for gender-equal parenting practices in Odisha.

The Wings4Her program, supported by Rolls-Royce India Private Limited, is creating **opportunities for girls in grades 11 and 12 to explore higher education and careers in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics).** By addressing stereotypes and building self-confidence, the program aims to inspire young women to unlock their full potential in science and technology.

Through mentorship, life skills training, career guidance, scholarships, parent workshops, and exposure to STEMrelated careers, the program equips girls with the tools they need to succeed. This year, orientation sessions were held across four schools, with enthusiastic participation from students eager to be part of this initiative.

For FY 2024-25, Wings4Her will support **350 girls** with career guidance and a range of developmental activities, reinforcing its commitment to empowering the next generation of women leaders in STEM.



Building on its successful legacy, the Skills-Based Livelihood Project by OneStage and Pehel Foundation continues to transform the lives of women from migrant construction worker communities. This year, the program aims to **reach 270 women, equipping them with skills in tailoring and garment manufacturing to help them secure dignified employment and steady incomes.**

Beneficiaries have achieved remarkable milestones, with many doubling their household earnings and gaining financial independence. This phase builds on that success, offering not just training but also critical support, such as childcare services and bridge education for participants' children.

Challenges persist, including securing job placements, providing adequate childcare, and overcoming societal barriers. Yet, the enthusiasm among participants remains strong, with 95% expressing a keen interest in further training to enhance their skills and career prospects.

The project's mission is to improve economic stability by increasing household incomes and expanding employment opportunities. Beyond financial empowerment, it addresses social challenges, creating a supportive ecosystem for women migrant workers to thrive.

While the journey is ongoing, the progress made so far highlights the transformative impact of skill-based interventions. Together, we're building a pathway to economic independence and brighter futures for these women and their families.



The OneStage project, supported by GlobalLogic Technologies Pvt Ltd, is changing the lives of underprivileged children by **focusing on education, emotional well-being, and physical health.** It addresses barriers such as financial challenges and limited mobility, creating an inclusive and supportive environment. The initiative also **promotes gender equality**, ensuring both boys and girls have equal opportunities to thrive and break societal stereotypes.

Parental involvement is a cornerstone of the program, as many underprivileged children lack this support. OneStage engages with parents to highlight the importance of education, leading to better attendance, improved academic performance, and increased chances of completing school. Special efforts are made to support girls, ensuring they receive the resources needed to succeed.

The program's **activity-based learning makes education engaging and fun**. Students participate in creative activities and sports like cricket and Kabaddi, which foster teamwork, confidence, and fitness. Events such as Children's Day celebrations create joy and strengthen bonds among students and teachers.

Experiential learning further enriches the initiative. in Q3, a recent visit to the Salar Jung Museum allowed students to explore iconic artefacts like the "Veiled Rebecca" statue, sparking curiosity and linking classroom lessons to real-world experiences. Teachers observed how these activities enhanced critical thinking, teamwork, and enthusiasm for learning. These visits are an integral part of the program, offering students the opportunity to witness and actively participate in transformative experiences

OneStage identifies waterstressed clusters in Haryana under the PANI program Lighting Up Lives: Solar Energy Brings Hope to Morena



This quarter, under the **PANI (Provide and Augment Natural Resource-based Interventions)** program, OneStage has made significant progress in addressing water scarcity in Haryana's critical regions, including Gurgaon, Sohna, Nuh, Mechana, and Mewat.



OneStage Hosts ToT Program for Sustainable Agriculture

OneStage proudly **announces the completion of a three-day Training of Trainers (ToT) program**, held from December 11-13, 2024, in Savli, Vadodara, Gujarat. In collaboration with Corteva Agri Seeds Pvt. Ltd., the initiative is empowering women farmers and volunteers with practical knowledge on silage crop management and sustainable agricultural practices to enhance livestock nutrition and reduce environmental impact.



For the first time in 30 years, Morena, Madhya Pradesh, shines bright as OneStage, with support from Corteva AgriScience Pvt. Ltd. India, installed **200 solar-powered streetlights across 13 Gram Panchayats in October 2024.** This Nature-Based Solution has transformed lives by enhancing safety, mobility, and productivity after sunset.

A Hetampur Gram Sabha member shared, "*Fear* has reduced, and productivity among villagers has increased." Women feel safer, children enjoy outdoor play, and businesses thrive under the lights.

On the Move: OneStage Launches Mobile Medical Clinic in Mumbai

OneStage, in collaboration with Aon India Insurance Brokers and Wockhardt Foundation, launched a Mobile Medical Clinic in Mumbai on December 12, 2024. This initiative aims to provide quality healthcare to **underserved communities in Dharavi, Govandi, and Andheri, benefiting around 5,000 individuals over three months**.

IIT-IIT- Rejuvenation of Water Bodies (RWB): A Step Towards Sustainability

OneStage is proud to announce the initiation of the *Rejuvenation of Water Bodies (RWB)* project in partnership with IIT-IIT. This transformative initiative, spanning from November 2024 to December 2025, focuses on **revitalizing stagnant water bodies in three key locations—Gorakhpur, Prayagraj (Uttar Pradesh), and Begusarai (Bihar).** In its first phase, we successfully identified clusters and conducted comprehensive ground-truthing exercises to understand the existing structures and conditions of water bodies. The detailed assessment was completed, providing a robust foundation for effective implementation. The project **adopts a community-centric approach, engaging local stakeholders to ensure sustainable outcomes.** Desiltation will not only restore the water bodies but also generate silt that farmers can use to enrich agricultural fields, enhancing soil fertility and supporting livelihoods.

Travel Diary: My Journey of witnessing change in Karnataka

It's always exciting to travel, but heading to Bangalore felt special, knowing the impact I was about to witness on the ground. As the plane touched down, I couldn't help but notice the bustling energy of the airport, where the city's rhythm seemed to beat louder with every step. The drive from the airport to the field was long but beautiful. The countryside unfolded before me like a painting, dotted with lush greenery and winding roads that promised stories waiting to be uncovered.

Later, I had the chance to meet potential donors interested in expanding our work in Karnataka. The conversations were encouraging, as they shared our vision of scaling impactful solutions to reach more children. Their support could open new doors, ensuring no child is left behind.

Bangalore itself offered its own charm. Amid the busy days, I found moments to explore the city, savoring its famous filter coffee and walking through its lively streets. The warmth of the people and the city's vibrant culture made me feel at home, even as a visitor.

As the trip came to an end, I felt a mix of emotions—gratitude for the incredible work being done, hope for what lies ahead, and a renewed sense of responsibility to keep pushing boundaries. This journey wasn't just about projects and meetings; it was a testament to the power of collaboration, the spirit of resilience, and the belief that change, no matter how small, can create ripples that reach far and wide.
