Championing systems led, equity driven development, OneStage reaffirmed its commitment to partnerships and evidence based action that translate sustainability ambition into meaningful, community level impact.



## From Crisis to Care in Flood Affected Punjab



In flood affected areas Punjab, OneStage partnered with Rio Tinto India to launch OneCare: Aarogya Wheels, restoring primary healthcare access for vulnerable communities in Gurdaspur. Delivering consultations, medicines, diagnostics, and psychosocial support at the doorstep, the initiative prioritizes those most at risk, transforming emergency response into sustained recovery while strengthening trust, dignity, and community resilience.

## Aarogya Wheels Advances Last-Mile Healthcare in Nuh, Haryana

OneStage has launched on ground operations of Aarogya Wheels in Haryana's Nuh district, reaching 15,000+ residents across five underserved villages. Supported by Evaluateserve Education Foundation, the mobile health unit delivers primary care, screenings, and preventive awareness, bridging access gaps, enabling early diagnosis, and strengthening public health linkages to ensure equitable, last mile healthcare.



## Laying the Groundwork for Resilient Recovery in Gurdaspur

Through the OneCare Disaster Rehabilitation Project, OneStage conducted a need and feasibility assessment across flood affected villages in Gurdaspur. Identifying schools, Anganwadi Centres, and critical infrastructure needs, the initiative prioritizes safer community spaces and sustained support reinforcing OneStage's commitment to rehabilitation that restores dignity, strengthens resilience, and enables communities to rebuild with confidence.



## Strengthening Pathways to Inclusion Through Partnership

OneStage engaged with district welfare officials to advance its work with Persons with Disabilities under the JEET initiative, supported by Pernod Ricard India Foundation. Focused on awareness, service linkages, and livelihood pathways, the dialogue reinforced collaborative action bridging policy and people to expand access, dignity, and opportunity for more inclusive communities.



## Weaving Stronger Futures for Artisan Communities

Through Pernod Ricard India Foundation supported initiative, Weaving Dreams, OneStage engaged bell metal artisans in Kondagaon to strengthen market access and sustainable livelihoods. With growing digital adoption, emerging business skills, and a focus on SHGs, producer groups, and buyer linkages, the initiative is transforming traditional craftsmanship into resilient, market connected enterprises rooted in confidence, opportunity, and long-term growth.
